Orientalions Gallery carries Japanese decorative arts of the 18th, 19th and 20th centuries: exquisite antique cloisonné enamels, bronzes, married metalwork inlaid with *shakudo* and *shibuichi*, art lacquer, carvings in wood and ivory including *okimono* and *netsuke*, *ojime*, *inro*, textiles including *fukusa*, *kesa* and *obi*, silver and articulated insects and animals and Satsuma.
